

PELTERET FAMILY TREE in FRANCE 1673 - 1727

Pelteret ancestors were living in various villages and towns in the Cote d'Or in the 17th to 19th centuries. The name PELTERET or PELLET(E)RET (a diminutive form of PELTIER or PELLETIER, which probably means the one who makes furs and sells them) can be found in the area of Is-sur-Tille ¹, where the church is under the patronage of St. Leger.

The link of the then Grancey le Chateau in the Bishopric of Langres ² in Champagne to the Pelteret family in South Africa is made through the holographic will of LEGER PELTERET, which is lodged in the London Metropolitan Archives and Guildhall Library Manuscripts, London, England ³. To-day, Grancey-le-Château-Neuveville is a community of several hundred persons in Burgundy in the Côte-d'Or, eastern France ⁴.

Census Register of the Cote-d'Or, parish and / or civil 1683-1760; Year 1723, Grancey le Chateau, Page 440/778 contains the following entry:

LEGER PELTERET, Son of Francois Pelteret a draper of Grancey and Marguerite Aubertot, husband and wife, was born 25th March 1723 and was baptised the same day. Leger Pelteret was godfather and godmother Anne Aubertot. The Godfather is nominated by the prior and parish priest Father Loison of Grancey.
